Travelling east from San Francisco, you will cross the Bay Bridge then, after passing Altamont Pass, the vast expanse of the San Joaquin Valley comes into view. Continue onto the foothills of the Sierra Nevada Mountain Range to the entrance of Yosemite Valley and National Park. Drive up to Tunnel View to see most of Yosemite Valley including El Capitan, Bridal Veil Falls and the Half Dome.

Driving on the south side of Merced River, you see The Three Brothers, Sentinel Rock, Yosemite Falls and meadows. As you pass the Chapel and Sentinel Bridge, you'll arrive at Yosemite Lodge at approximately 1:45pm for lunch. (own expense)

With two hours free time, you can walk to Yosemite Falls or take the free shuttle to the Visitor Centre with its range of exhibits and a self guided nature trail.

Your coach departs Yosemite Lodge at approximately 3:45 pm for its return trip to San Francisco, stopping at El Portal and Merced, and arriving into San Francisco after 8:30 pm.

Deposit: A deposit of \$500 per person is required within 7 days of confirmation of your reservation. This deposit is Non Refundable.

Final payment: The balance of money must be received by 30 January . It may be necessary to pay for flights in advance of this date. Passengers will be advised if early payment for flights is required.

Payment methods: Payment can be made by cash, cheque, direct deposit and credit card. Credit Cards incur the following surcharge above the tour cost. Visa, Mastercard 1.5% - American Express and Diners Club 3%.

Cancellations: In the event of cancellation, you agree to pay the cancellation fees listed. Travel insurance is strongly recommended and provides protection against most legitimate reasons for cancellation.
