### **31 MAY 11 – TUESDAY**

Today you will be collected from your home and transferred to your local airport for flight to Sydney. On arrival in Sydney you will transfer to our accommodation.  
Accommodation: Mercure Sydney Airport

### **01 JUNE 11 - WEDNESDAY**

This morning we will transfer from accommodation to Sydney International Airport in preparation for our flight to Vancouver with Air Canada.

Depart Sydney 10.25am  
Arrive Vancouver 7.30am

Upon arrival at Vancouver airport you will be met and transferred to the ferry for the cruise across Georgia Strait to Vancouver Island. Travel to Victoria the charming capital of British Columbia, famous for its distinct British feel. Check into your hotel and then tonight, enjoy an informal Welcome Reception.

Accommodation: (Two Nights): Victoria, Queen Victoria Hotel & Suites.

### **02 JUNE 11 - THURSDAY**

This morning visit the famous Butchart Garden to explore the floral displays. The remainder of the day is free. You may wish to walk and explore or perhaps take a whale watching cruise or a horse drawn carriage ride, maybe high tea at the Empress Hotel (all own expense). (B)



### **03 JUNE 11 - FRIDAY**

This morning board the ferry and return to the mainland. Enjoy a sightseeing tour of Vancouver including Waterfront, Gastown and Stanley Park. The remainder of the day is at leisure for you to explore the unofficial capital of Western Canada.

Accommodation: Vancouver, Blue Horizon Hotel. (B)

### **04 JUNE 11 - SATURDAY**

Travel out of Vancouver this morning and into the Cariboo area of British Columbia enroute to the Rock Mountains. Arrive at the summer playground of Sun Peaks for your overnight stay.

Accommodation: Sun Peaks, Heatherstone Lodge. (BD)

### **05 JUNE 11 - SUNDAY**

Travel through Glacier and Mt Revelstoke National Parks, over Kicking Horse Pass and through Yoho National Park. On arrival at the Mountain Town of Banff, check into your hotel.

Accommodation (two nights) Banff, Banff Park Lodge. (BD)

**06 JUNE 11 – MONDAY**

Today ride the Banff Gondola up the shoulder of Sulphur Mountain to enjoy an incredible view of the Canadian Rockies. The rest of the day is at leisure. Perhaps visit the historical The Fairmont Springs Hotel, a landmark of the Rockies, or take a wilderness experience tour to discover the local flora and fauna (own expense). (B)

**07 JUNE 11 - TUESDAY**

Travel the short distance to arrive at the Jewel of the Rockies, Lake Louise. This tranquil lake is renowned for its captivating turquoise waters, and breathtaking alpine backdrop. Accommodation: Lake Louise, The Fairmont Chateau Lake Louise. (BD)



**08 JUNE 11 - WEDNESDAY**

Journey along the spectacular Icefields Parkway, with vistas of glaciers, lakes and wildlife. Stop at Athabasca Glacier for an Ice Explorer ride. Accommodation: Jasper, Tonquin Inn. (BD)

**09 JUNE 11 - THURSDAY**

Early today board the Rock Mountaineer train and relax in the comfort of your Red Leaf carriage. Pass by Mt Robson, the highest peak in the Canadian Rockies at 3,954 metres. View the expansive glaciers of the Albert Icefields and the Pyramid Falls. See the snow capped Monashee Mountains before following the Thompson River through to Kamloops, arriving late this afternoon. Perhaps take in an entertaining dinner show (own expense). Accommodation in Kamloops is allocated by Rocky Mountaineer Vacations. (BL)



### **10 JUNE 11 - FRIDAY**

Rejoining the 'Rocky Mountaineer', continue westward towards the Pacific Coast. See the thundering waters of Hell's Gate in the Fraser Canyon. View the towering peaks of the Coast Mountains and pass through the fertile fields of the Fraser Valley. On today's journey you will see dramatic changes in scenery. Arrive Vancouver late afternoon.

Accommodation: Vancouver, Blue Horizon Hotel. (BLD)

### **11 JUNE 11 - SATURDAY**

Today you board your Holland America Line cruise ship and settle into your comfortable Inside Stateroom (\* Book early for your guaranteed outside stateroom upgrade, limited availability) as you sail north towards the inside passage and the famous Canada/Alaska coastal icefields.

### **12 JUNE 11 - SUNDAY**

Enjoy a day at sea as your ship wends its way past rocky headlands, over the still blue waters of the inside passage. (BLD)

### **13 JUNE 11 - MONDAY**

This afternoon in Juneau, Alaska's capital, where you might like to experience a dog sled ride over a glacier, sample a salmon baked over a fire or pan for gold (own expense). (BLD)



### **14 JUNE 11 - TUESDAY**

At the northernmost point of the Inside Passage, Skagway's history as a frontier town and gateway for the gold rush is still evident. Enjoy free time discovering what gold prospecting was like back then or take in the wildlife (own expense). (BLD)

**15 JUN 11 - WEDNESDAY**

Wake up to the breathtaking sight of Glacier Bay National Park with its rivers of ice. Watch out for huge icebergs crashing dramatically into the ocean below. Rangers come onboard to explain the geological wonders and point out the diverse wildlife of the region. (BLD)

**16 JUNE 11 - THURSDAY**

As the salmon capital of the world. Ketchikan is the place to indulge in all things salmon. During time at leisure, perhaps join a walking tour of the town, or immerse yourself in the Tlingit Indian culture at Saxman Native Village. All at own expense) (BLD)



**17 JUNE 11 - FRIDAY**

Heading south through the Inside Passage watch the majestic landscape slip by. (BLD)

**18 JUNE 11 - SATURDAY**

Disembark in Vancouver after breakfast. Enjoy time at leisure before your transfer to the airport for your return flight to Sydney on Air Canada.

**19 JUNE 11 - SATURDAY**

In flight crossing the international date line.

**20 JUNE 11 - THURSDAY**

On arrival in Sydney we will transfer to the domestic terminal for onward flight to our home port. On arrival you will be transferred to your home.

## **BOOKING CONDITIONS**

**Lead In Package Price: (Earlybird Bookings):** From \$9375 per person twin share companion fly free offer must be two passengers in booking. Offer closes 15 October and is subject to availability.

**Normal Package Cost:** \$10,828 per person twin share.

**Deposit:** A non refundable deposit of \$2000 per person plus Airfare is required within 7 days of confirmation of your reservation.

**Final payment:** The tour price indicated \$9375 is the special group discount price for Casino Travel Shoppe clients and is subject to change due to unforeseen increases in taxes and fuel surcharges.

Free upgrades are based on strictly limited seats on set departures, subject to availability.

Bookings received or paid after 15 October will revert to the normal package price of \$10,828 per person.
