Following collection from your home you will be transferred to the airport for your flight to Prague.

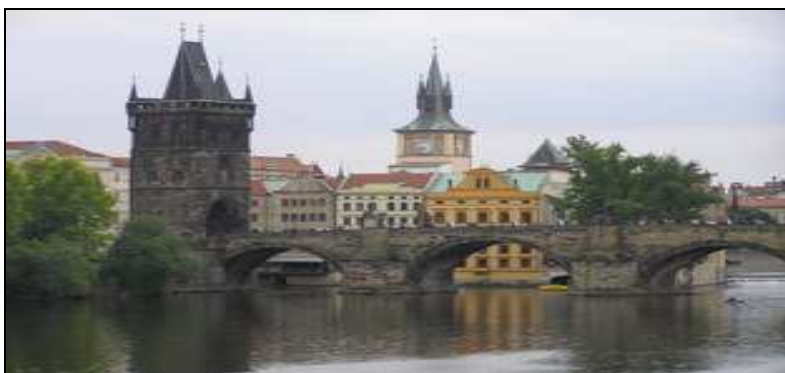

SATURDAY 02 JULY

Today we enjoy a half-day city sightseeing tour including entrance to Prague Castle and the Old Town followed by an afternoon at leisure or an optional cruise. This evening we walk to a local restaurant for a folklore dinner. (BD)

Sunday 03 July 2011

This morning after breakfast we depart deep into the southern Bohemian countryside to the picturesque medieval town of Cesky Krumlov. The very first UNESCO listed town in the Czech Republic. Nestled at the base of the Samava Forest and hugging the Vltava River, Cesky Krumlov's beauty has been preserved for centuries. Walking through the cobble stone streets of the old town make your way to the castle, one of the biggest in Central Europe to visit the interiors and admire the magnificent views. Lunch is included. (BL)

Monday 04 July 2011

Transfer to the Prague railway station for your journey to Krakow via Katowice.

Depart Prague at 10.11am

Arrive Krakow at 5.55pm on arrival we will transfer to our hotel, dinner will be at the hotel this evening. (BD)

Accommodation: Three nights Novotel Centrum, Krakow.

Tuesday 05 July 2011

Krakow was once the royal capital of Poland. A morning tour takes you to the Old Town to see St Marys Church, Jagiellonian University and Cloth Hall, then visit Wawel Castle and Cathedral. This afternoon we take the optional excursion to the famous Wieliczka Salt Mines, an amazing labyrinth of underground tunnels. This evening we enjoy a Polish dinner at a local restaurant “Miod I Wino” (BD)

Wednesday 06 July 2011

This morning we take an excursion to Oswiecim for a tour of Auschwitz – Birkenau concentration camp. Lunch will be taken at Restaurant “Art Deco” before returning to Krakow. Tonight dinner will be taken at Restaurant “Arka Noego” (BLD)



Thursday 07 July 2011

Depart Krakow and head Warsaw. On arrival in Warsaw enjoy a sightseeing of Warsaw takes you along the Royal Route and into the Old Town with its Royal Castle and bustling Market Square. Sightseeing will include St John’s Cathedral, Castle Square with King Sigismunds Column, Mermaid Statue, Maria Curie Museum, the Warsaw Uprising Monument, Ghetto area and Tomb of the Unknown Soldier. Dinner this evening will be at Restaurant “Dekanta”
Accommodation: Two nights Holiday Inn, Warsaw. (BD)

Friday 08 July 2011

We take a morning tour to visit Wilanow Palace and park, the afternoon is at leisure. Dinner will be at our hotel. (BD)



Saturday 09 July 2011

Today after breakfast we travel into Lithuania to Vilnius arriving around 4pm where we check into our hotel and then enjoy a short orientation walk to restaurant "Lokys" for dinner.(BD)

Accommodation: Two nights Artis Hotel, Vilnius.

Sunday 10 July 2011

This mornings sightseeing tour includes Hill of Three Crosses with a panoramic view of the 'Stebuklas' Tile, Old Town with Vilnius Cathedral, St Anna's Church, St Bernadine's Church, Old University and Chapel of Dawn, Gediminas Tower, free time for optional lunch. In the afternoon visit Traki, the medieval capital of Lithuania, and Traki Castle visit. We transfer back to our hotel for dinner. (BD)



Monday 11 July 2011

After breakfast we travel to Klaipeda with time for lunch before a city sightseeing tour visiting the Old Town and St Johns Church. We then proceed to our hotel to freshen up prior to an orientation walk to the restaurant "Tavaros Anike" for dinner. (BD)

Accommodation: Two nights Hotel Europa Royal Klaipeda.

Tuesday 12 July 2011

This morning after breakfast we transfer by ferry to Smyltene and commence a tour of Curonian Spit, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and National Park, visit to Juodkrante and Nida before return travel back to Klaipeda for dinner at our hotel. (BD)

Wednesday 13 July 2011

This morning we transfer to Riga via Rundale where we visit Rundale Palace with free time for lunch. Continuing to Riga we take a panoramic city tour including the Art Nouveau District with Albert Street National Opera House, Freedom Monument before checking into our hotel. This evening we take the orientation walk to our restaurant 'Salve' (BD)

Accommodation: Two nights Hotel Nordic Bellevue.



Thursday 14 July 2011

Riga founded in 1201, is a true kaleidoscope of architectural styles. Your walking tour of the Old Town includes Dome Cathedral, St Peters Church, Powder Tower, Large and Small Guild Houses and Blackheads House with free time for lunch. . The afternoon offers a visit to the Ethnographical Open Air Museum, an exposition of 18th Century country life. Dinner this evening will be at the hotel. (BD)

Friday 15 July 2011

This morning we travel to Sigulda and visit Gauja National Park with a visit to Turaida Castle with free time for lunch before travelling on to Tallinn in Estonia. On arrival we check into our hotel around 5pm and take an orientation walk around 6.30pm to our restaurant 'Daube' for dinner. (BD)
Accommodation: Two nights Hotel Scandic Palace.

Saturday 16 July 2011

Explore the walled city of Tallinn on a walking tour and see Toompea Castle, Dome Cathedral, and Old Town Hall. In the afternoon take an excursion to Kadriorg Park with its baroque palace built for Peter the Great. Your final evening is celebrated with a dinner at your hotel. (BD)



Sunday 17 July 2011

Your tour concludes after breakfast with a free day to explore at leisure before an afternoon transfer to the seaport for your overnight ferry to Stockholm. (BD)

Monday 18 July 2011

On arrival in Stockholm we check into our hotel and have free time to explore this beautiful Scandinavian City. Perhaps an afternoon at the Vasa Museum. (B)
